

D Card Holder

To make this quilt you will need:

Two 8 1/2" x wof (width of fabric) strips of patchwork fabric.

One 6 1/2" x wof strip of clean vinyl.

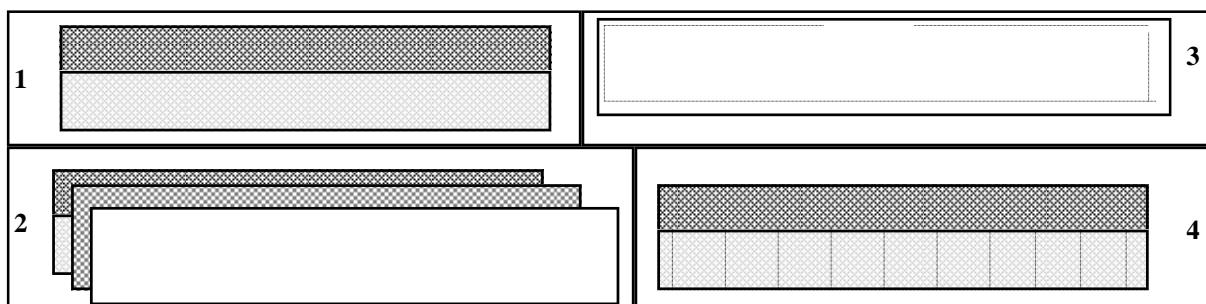
One 8 1/2" x 42" (approx) strip of Wadding

100% cotton thread

1m thin ribbon or braid

Sewing machine

Pins



1. Layer one 8 1/2" strip of patchwork fabric (right side), with the 6 1/2" strip of clear vinyl, pin to secure the vinyl in position. Take care to only pin within the seam allowance otherwise the vinyl will get holes in it that will not close back up!
2. Layer the second 8 1/2" strip of patchwork fabric (right sides together) with the other strip and vinyl, secure with pins. Finally stack the wadding on top, and sew the stack together using 1/4" seams. Leave a 2" opening at the top of the stack so you can turn through.
3. Turn the stack right sides out and hand stitch closed the opening.
4. Next stitch pockets to hold the D'Cards. Use masking tape to mark your stitching lines, beginning with the center of the holder, and measuring every 3 1/2" on either side. If you have small pockets at the ends these can be used to hold your stylus or pen. Snap your Vinyl foot onto your machine and stitch the pockets.
5. Finally, attach ribbon/braid to the outside of the D'Card Holder on the outside, using your machine.

A basic knowledge of Patchwork and Quilting has been assumed in this pattern. Concepts such as strip piecing and chain piecing are assumed, as are techniques such as rotary cutting, cutting from templates, construction of half square triangles etc. If you are not familiar with some or any of these techniques M.A.D. retails a range of "Beginners Guide to ..." instruction cards.
